APPROVAL OF MINUTES ~ Sherrie Gottfried moved for approval of the September 2015 Minutes. Kris Adams seconded. Motion passed as follows: Bonney-Hill, Zahniser, Gottfried and Adams in favor with Ecklund abstaining and two positions vacant.

APPEARANCE OF INTERESTED CITIZENS: Member-elect Ashley Wenger attended the meeting. Members of the committee introduced themselves and welcomed her.

OLD NEW/BUSINESS

Keizer Heritage Foundation Update: Sherrie Gottfried reported there had been no meeting held.

PROJECTS/REPORTS

Flood History River Marker at Boat Ramp Update:

- *Flood Sign:* Committee members reviewed the signs and made a few formatting changes. Anita Zahniser moved to submit the signs to the Parks Board for approval after the changes are made. Sherrie Gottfried seconded. Motion passed as follows: Bonney-Hill, Zahniser, Gottfried, Ecklund and Adams in favor with two positions vacant.

Members indicated that they would attend the November 10 Parks Board meeting to make the presentation.

Oral History:

- *Kris Adams* reported that she sent Jeff Boucher information and sample questions and hopes to hear back from him soon. He still has to talk to his family. She has not talked to Marie Zielinski.
- *Jill Bonney-Hill* reported that she had not heard back from Lyndon Zaitz and assumed that his silence indicated that he was not interested.
- *Sherrie Gottfried* reported that Betty Hart had not gotten back to her but she would be seeing her soon and would talk to her then about getting an interview with Mike Hart.
- *Anita Zahniser* reported that the Freshour interview was done on Wednesday; Keizer Kids will be on November 13. She is also getting to know another interview candidate, Joy Beebe, and reading her book called "Snapshots of a War Bride".

Status of Geo-caches: Kris Adams volunteered to monitor the caches. The committee discussed details such as which ones were still active, what should go in the caches, size, advertising them on the Facebook page and login requirements. Members voiced the desire to have caches located at or near existing Points of Interest. Ms. Adams indicated she would work with Mike Hickman (former member who started the caches).

Claggett Creek Cemetery: Kris Adams noted that applications for grants need to be approved by Council. Following discussion committee members decided that rather than focusing on improvements for the cemetery, they would work on putting together an informational sign with photographs for the cemetery.

Facebook Page: Bev Ecklund gave instructions to the committee on use of the Facebook page and explained how to administer the page. Discussion followed regarding various ideas for postings.

OTHER BUSINESS: Members reviewed a list of projects that could be pursued now that the flood history sign is complete.

Sherrie Gottfried moved to start working on researching the Savage House for a sign. Bev Ecklund seconded.

An amendment was made to the motion to include working on a historical sign for the Claggett Creek Cemetery. Ms. Gottfried and Ms. Ecklund accepted the amendment.

Motion passed as follows: Bonney-Hill, Zahniser, Gottfried, Ecklund and Adams in favor with two positions vacant.
