

**City of Keizer
Bikeways Committee
October 8, 1997**

Meeting was attended by Hersch Sangster, Lori Deibert, Tillman Bennett, Joe Edgell, Jack McElwain, and Preston VanMeter. Meeting was called to order. Minutes were reviewed and approved.

First on the agenda, was the expiration of terms for Lori, Jack, and Preston. Jack said that he would not continue on this committee at the end of this term. We appreciate and thank him for his time on this committee. Lori & Preston both plan to renew their term on the committee. Joe will talk to Tracy regarding how to replace a member and also on the length of the term for Lori, Preston, and any new member.

We next discussed the Grant for bike lanes on Delight and Cummings. We missed the opportunity to get the grant this year. We will follow-up on the Grant in 1998 (May/June 1998).

We are still working on the signage and striping of bike lanes in Keizer. Hersch is working on a letter to the City of Keizer, attention Wally Mull. We also discussed our desire for bike lanes on Windsor Island Rd out to the Water Treatment Plant.

The Volcano's owners will also be contacted in the next month about bike racks at the Stadium.

We talked extensively about some bicycle safety classes this spring. We will aim for 3 classes in April/May. We will contact Irene Fernandez (Whiteaker Middle School), Kennedy and Cummings Elementary Schools. We will be contacting many agencies to get help with these classes/bike rodeos, etc., such as the Keizer Police Dept. (Mark Miranda), Explorer Scouts, State Farm, etc.

Barry Evensen attended the Traffic Safety Commission Meeting in September, but was not able to make it to the meeting tonight. He sent his report with Hersch, and Hersch reviewed their meeting with us. They are planning to turn most bike issues over to this committee. We will continue our liaison with them and Lori will attend their October meeting.

Next meeting is going to be on Tuesday, November 18, 1997. Meeting was adjourned.

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
