Councilor Newton moved to authorize the City Manager to contract for the cleaning of Labish Ditch. Councilor Miller seconded the Motion.

Councilor Watson confirmed the developer of the Hidden Creek and Country Glen subdivisions will pay for the costs of this cleaning. He suggested requiring the contractor cleaning the ditch to provide a bond covering any potential damage that may occur.

City Manager Tryk pointed out the developers will be covering the costs associated with removal of all of the debris indicated on the maps. She indicated there is not any identified debris near the Swingwood area. In addition this map covers the area along the ditch to River Road.

Councilor Watson requested staff review the removal of a tree near his property on Manzanita.

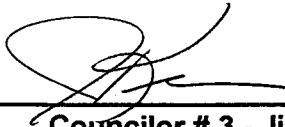


Councilor #4 - Carl Beach

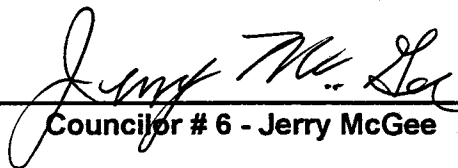
