OLD NEW/BUSINESS

Keizer Heritage Foundation Update: Sherrie Gottfried reported there had been no meeting held.

PROJECTS/REPORTS

Flood History River Marker at Boat Ramp Update:

- *Flood Sign:* Committee members viewed a prototype of the sign and decided formatting details. Staff showed specs on the proposed signage and photographs of the general location.
- *Marker:* Staff reported that Public Works Director Bill Lawyer will provide a pole which will be marked with the flood levels of the 1861 and 1890 flood levels; 1943 and 1996 will be marked on the boat ramp pavement; it is unclear where the 1964 marking will be placed – depending on survey results.

Status of Geo-caches: Erica Hedberg resigned from the committee. Kris Adams volunteered to monitor the caches until another member wants to take over.

Oral History:

- *Kris Adams* reported that she has contacted Steve Boucher who has indicated that he wants to discuss this with his brothers and sisters prior to agreeing to an interview. She has been unable to contact Marie Zielinski.
- *Jill Bonney-Hill* reported that she had talked to Lyndon Zaitz about interviewing his father but he was non-committal. She urged Lyndon to watch some of the interviews being aired on K-23 to alleviate his concerns.
- *Bev Ecklund* – absent.
- *Anita Zahniser* provided details about the program she is planning relating to the 'Keizer Kids' noting that she will be doing the interviews at the Heritage Center on Friday, November 13 at 2 p.m. She also presented at Willamette Lutheran. Ms. Zahniser suggested that someone on the committee interview Joe Hobson of Hobson & Lien focusing on the incorporation of Keizer. She provided additional information about potential interviewees and concluded noting that she will be interviewing Millie Freshour on Wednesday.
