David Loudon seconded. Motion passed as follows: Becker, Loudon, Castro and Cejka  
in favor with Busch abstaining and two positions vacant.

**OTHER BUSINESS:** Chair Busch explained that at the last Council meeting the Mayor had suggested that the committee research the signs at the Keizer Little League Park. He noted that research on the park and its history has already been done and a history document and an interview with founders (done through the Oral History Project) are posted on the city website. Regarding preservation of signage at the park, Chair Busch suggested that this was not the purpose of the committee. Both Chair Busch and Robert Becker suggested that any research that might be needed could be referred to the Cultural Center. The committee there could take on the task and perhaps the City could assist with funding signage if that was appropriate.

Lisa Cejka moved that the Committee recommend Council acknowledge that the Keizer Points of Interest Committee has fulfilled its purpose and should therefore be dissolved.  
Robert Becker seconded. Motion passed as follows: Busch, Becker, Cejka, Castro and Loudon in favor with two positions absent.

He announced the Willamette Cleanup event on October 2, urged committee members to donate bottled water to area schools, commended Audrey Butler and the Latinos in Action Committee, and announced the upcoming Council Work Session.
