MINUTES

The Meeting was called to order by Hersch Sangster. Minutes from last month were reviewed and approved.

Hersch talked about the Helmet Diversion class set for 9/22. A pre-class review was done with the KPD and KFD on 9/14. The lesson plan appears to be ready. The mayor and Judy plan on helping with the opening remarks.

Benjamin spoke on the plans for the DaySpring Bicycle Skills fair on 9/23 -. Barry, Hersch and Trevor will be able to attend.

Joe talked about and our helmet give away. Joe received the last order, which included more skate helmets. This should be enough for the Diversion class on 9/22 and the DaySpring event. The bicycle/skateboard give away is set for 10/6 at 2 p.m. at the Gazebo. So far there have been over 149 entries through the CircleK and police encouragement/enforcement program.

At the June meeting David Philbrick, had a question about speed and crossing issues on Lockhaven at the last meeting. Public Works was contacted about traffic calming that might work in the area including crossing. The City Engineer has recommended against any mid-block crossings as calming devices. A letter was sent last week from the KBAC in support of a study of this crossing and the problem on Lockhaven. At City Council the Engineer again was against any crossing and had a high cost for the study. The City Council did not approve a study just yet.

Joe attended the August Traffic Safety meeting. Joe informed them of our safety and helmet sessions and the up coming DaySpring and Diversion class.

A letter of support went to the Willamette River Initiative to support a National Parks study of a Willamette greenway multi-use path.

Hersch and Doug attended a COG Regional Bicycle/Pedestrian Workshop. The workshop wanted input on bicycle facilities for the next 20 years. The KBAC mention the greenway idea. Hersch will send the KBAC wish list to the COG.
