APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Dennis Koho moved for approval of the minutes of June 8, 1993 with Mark Caillier seconding the motion. The motion passed unanimously by those members present.

PLANNING COMMISSION APPOINTMENTS

The Committee reviewed several applications for two vacancies on the Planning Commission. JoAnne Beilke moved to reappoint Marty Matiskainen for a three-year term on the Planning Commission. Mike Gaynor seconded this motion with unanimous passage by those members present. Dennis Koho moved to appoint Denny Muchmore to fill a three-year term on the Planning Commission. JoAnne Beilke seconded this motion with unanimous passage by those members present.

SERVICE LEARNING - MCNARY HIGH SCHOOL

Mark Caillier advised the Committee he has been discussing a volunteer service learning

program with Ken Feetham of McNary High School. This would allow student to volunteer work for the City and in return they could earn school credits. It would also allow the student to receive recognition for participation in a service learning program. McNary will be displaying a bulletin board at the school to advertise opportunities for students to participate. Mike Gaynor voiced his concern for allowing a student to receive free credits away from school. JoAnne Beilke suggested a trial basis with one student. She also suggested a committee representative talk with the student prior to his/her participation. Mark stated he will be attending a student body meeting in the future to explain the program to the students. Mayor Koho suggested a possible student take-over of city government for one day.

VOLUNTEER TRAINING SESSIONS

Mark Caillier advised the Committee the Volunteer Training Session was canceled due to the small attendance at the last session and the upcoming appointments to the Community Policing Committee. A session will be scheduled following these appointments.

OTHER BUSINESS

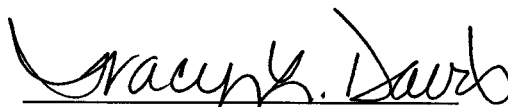
Community Policing Committee
