APPROVAL OF MINUTES ~ Joel Stein moved to approve the June 2010 Minutes. Eamon Bishop seconded. Motion passed as follows: Bradley, Dimatteo, Bishop, Stein and Hoover with McCormack absent at time of vote and Thompson absent.

APPEARANCE OF INTERESTED CITIZENS

Bob Wild Terrace Green in Keizer, inquired about the results of his request from the May meeting. He was shown the speed study report as well as Mr. Kissler's written report submitted for the July meeting which indicated that the average speed was within the accepted tolerance limits. Mr. Wild suggested that perhaps additional signage would be beneficial. Chair Bradley urged him to contact Public Works with his request. Councilor McKane concurred and suggested that Mr. Wild invite Officer LeDay or a Public Works representative to the next neighborhood association meeting.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS

Chemawa/River Road Intersection Conflicts: Commissioners referred to Mr. Kissler's report and to information submitted from the Keizer Police Department regarding this issue, but because Mr. Malone was not at the meeting, they agreed to table this issue until the September meeting.

BIKEWAYS REPORT ~ No Report.

POLICE LIAISON REPORT ~ No Report.

COUNCIL LIAISON REPORT ~ Councilor McKane reviewed Council actions taken at the August 16 meeting including adoption of resolutions and ordinances, discussion regarding irrigating the dog park at Keizer Rapids Park and approval of three more free concerts at the amphitheater. He also reported that the Good Vibrations promoter wants to come back to the area next year and the City of Keizer will be working with him to make the event even better. Reports from local businesses indicate that their business during that time was good. There were no incidents, arrests or injuries related to the event.

STAFF REPORT ~ Rob Kissler was not at the meeting but had submitted a monthly report via email. Commissioners discussed item number 5 which referred to complaints of speeding traffic on Wheatland Road. Several Commissioners noted that they lived on or near Wheatland and that it appeared that 90% of the traffic was observing the speed limit. They suggested perhaps more police presence would be beneficial. Chair Bradley noted that she would give this suggestion to Officer LeDay. In response to Mr. Kissler's request for input regarding initiation of another speed study for Wheatland Road, Commissioners indicated that they preferred knowing how much it would cost before recommending one. They indicated that if it was cheap they would be in favor of doing one.

COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE ~ Commission agreed there was no need to report to Council.
