Lesser Markers at Corners of Significant Land Claims: Jill Bonney-Hill explained the history of this project for the benefit of the new members and reported that she is working with David Loudon and Jerry McGee and will have more to report next month.

Informational Signage at Keizer School: Jill Bonney-Hill reported that she had met with the Heritage Board and they were in favor of the signage. They voted unanimously to

approve it and added that they want to have a say in what is put on the sign. They are fine with mounting in to the side of the building and with having one the same size as the flood history signs. They would also like to help with the sign at Schoolhouse Square.

Neighborhood History/Origination of Street Names: Rhonda Iken was not at the meeting – No Report.

Longitude 123: Ashley Wenger reported that she has done some research and found there is an internet-based project where people visit intersections of longitude and latitude.
