APPROVAL OF MINUTES ~ Anita Zahniser moved for approval of the June 2016 Minutes. Kris Adams seconded. Motion passed as follows: Bonney-Hill, Zahniser and Wenger in favor with Adams abstaining, Gottfried absent and two positions vacant.

OLD NEW/BUSINESS

Points of Interest Committee Tour: Discussion took place regarding tour logistics. Tour will begin at the Civic Center, go west on Chemawa past the Thomas Dove Keizer statue; turn north on River Road passing the Donation Land Claim and 45th Parallel marker; turn east on Lockhaven and north on Keizer Station Boulevard to Ryan J. Hill Memorial Park to view the Marie Dorion and Japanese History displays. Then retrace the route to River Road going north to Wheatland Road cutoff turning west on Bolf Terrace to the end and Claggett Cemetery. From there the committee will retrace the route to River and Chemawa turning west on Chemawa to the end and Keizer Rapids Park. The final leg will be retracing the route to River Road and Chemawa, turning south on River Road and west on Glynbrook to the end and Wallace House Park.

In order to make it to all the sites in a timely manner, there will be no presentations given. Participants will be given maps of all the sites and can read the summaries on the maps.

Changing Meeting Day: Ashley Wenger explained that her school schedule in September will involve a Tuesday night class and that she had also gotten a new job and could not make it to the meetings before 6. Committee members discussed changing the meeting day to Thursday and the time to 6 p.m.

Jill Bonney-Hill moved that the Keizer Points of Interest Committee change its meeting from the third Tuesday at 5:30 p.m. to the fourth Thursday at 6:00 p.m. beginning September 22. Ashley Wenger seconded. Motion passed as follows: Bonney-Hill, Zahniser, Wenger and Adams in favor with Gottfried absent and two positions vacant.

PROJECTS/REPORTS

Flood History River Marker at Boat Ramp Update:

- *Flood Sign:* Staff reported that the signs and posts have been ordered. When they are ready Public Works they will be picked up installed; staff will also arrange for the survey and installation and marking of the level marker pole and marking on the boat ramp.

Oral History:

- *Anita Zahniser* reported that Joy Beebe is still having health issues. She hopes to interview her as soon as she is well. She is working with Lynn Woolfe as the next interviewee.
- *Kris Adams* reported that Sherrie Gottfried has volunteered to be the 'go-between' but she has not talked with her to find out the status.
- *Ashley Wenger* reported that she would prefer to do research rather than participate in the Oral History project. She will familiarize herself with Keizer and see what else she can do.

Status of Geo-caches: Kris Adams reported that everything is outdated. She is going to regroup and figure out if the locations should stay the same or be changed. She suggested that locations tie into the points of interest.

Savage House: Jill Bonney-Hill distributed copies of her notes and asked committee members to review web pages to which she had copied the links. Anita Zahniser volunteered to give her contact information for Tammy Wild who has a wealth of information and is willing to share.

Facebook Page: Jill Bonney-Hill reported that she tries to update the page every month and is getting views but not many comments. She always reminds followers that the committee needs new members. The committee picture has been posted to the page.

Kris Adams announced that she has developed a Facebook page called "Alive and Well in Keizer". She posted old pictures and others are commenting and telling stories about things they remember. It is open to anyone who wants to share.
