The meeting was called to order by Hersch in City Hall Conference Room B. The June meeting minutes were reviewed.

Projects – Bill confirmed the Windsor Is. /Chemewa Rd Sewer project could have an overlay that includes a wider shoulder to accommodate bikes. Bicycle helmets have been ordered. The project will be starting next week on Chemewa. The road will be closed. N River Road will have overlays in August which include Bike lanes. Wheatland intersection is slated for improvement with lights is planned.

The Committee directed the chair to speak with the Bike Club to help develop enforcement and education to help improve the Cookie Monster Ride. Hersch contacted the Salem Bike Club and they are willing to help. Hersch will act as a liaison with Keizer and the Ride Coordinator – John Maurice. The Bike Club gave the KBAC \$589 for helmets and a bicycle safety video.

Richard talked about County grant monies that might be available to pathways/bike facilities. The earlier grant for developing a bridge over Labish Ditch in the Gubser area was not accepted by OPRD..
