

Keizer Emergency Management Meeting
Minutes
Tuesday, June 26, 2001

1. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Captain Barker at 4:10 p.m. in the absence of Sergeant Teague.

The following members were in attendance: Ted Plumb, Louis Neuman, Roger Williamson, Ray Hansen, Anne Rasmus, Bob Emmerich, Jerry Martin, Bruce Visser, Council Liaison-Jacque Moir, Rob Kissler-Public Works Director and Cindy Perry-Recording Secretary

2. New Emergency Manager:

Captain Barker shared that Sgt. Teague would be taking over the responsibilities as the new Emergency Manager. Welcome Sgt. Teague!

3. Incident Review:

Captain Barker reported the details of the incident that took place on 14th Avenue and included the death of a 67 year old woman and her son.

Jerry Martin with the Country Glen Neighborhood Association, who works for Marion County Search and Rescue, shared some of the recent search and rescue incidents that had taken place.

4. Public Works Update:

Rob Kissler, Public Works Director had no updates to provide to the Emergency Management Committee.

5. EVAK

Bob Emmerich addressed changes that had taken place for new volunteers that would include the requirement of a security check, attending an orientation within six months of signing up and attending an annual orientation/training. He noted the new schedule of activities that was available on EVAK's web site via the City of Keizer's site.

Council President Moir shared that the Planning Commission would be holding a Public Hearing regarding the Infill Master Plan on Wednesday, June 27th.

Bruce Visser provided a handout regarding the Earthquake exercise tentatively scheduled for October 18th, the goals and contact people for each agency affiliated in the drill.

Ted Plumb shared that the Natural Demonstration Project at the Treatment Plant was under way. He answered questions regarding the project indicating that its purpose was to act as a cooling process for effluent from the plant.

Roger Williamson reported with the tropical storms that had taken place in Texas and Louisiana that members of the Red Cross had been sent to respond to the need. He also noted that the Red Cross would be moving into their new building on Wallace Road.

Bob Newton noted that Bruce Knopp had shown an interest in being on the Emergency Operations Committee and told him to contact the City Recorder. Mr. Newton also expressed his appreciation regarding the excellent work done by the Police Department during the incident on 14th Avenue.
