OLD BUSINESS ~ COMMITTEE REPORTS

Oral History – Barbara Clement submitted names and contact information to Jill Bonney-Hill and reported that she had contacted with many people on the list and they were willing to be interviewed. Terri Hoag also provided names and contact information. Jill Bonney-Hill reported that she was working with Julie Wood on this project and that Rex Robertson with K-23 is willing to film the interviews on the first and third Mondays. Jill will work on contacting the people to set up interviews. Additional discussion took place regarding doing the interviews at the interviewees' homes. Members agreed that Evelyn Franz should be approached regarding doing an interview on July 6 with Jill developing the questions. Jill agreed to contact Jason Heimerdinger with the K-23 Committee to see if he would be willing to interview or if he has students who would like to participate. Committee members also suggested asking Jason Cox with the Keizer Times if he would like to interview. Terri Hoag agreed to do the interview if Jason was not available.

Heritage Trees – Terri Hoag reported that she has been working on the Marie Dorian event so has not done anything on this. She noted, however, that she is planning on meeting with Wilbur Bluhm soon.

Calvary Remount Station – Terri Hoag reported that she had the information but has not moved forward on it. Sherrie Gottfried added that she would be assisting Terri on this.

They suggested he check with Jerry McGee to see if there were any more Points of Interest signs available to post on River Road directing people to the informational sign at the golf course.

The event is scheduled for July 10 at 2 p.m. The Keizer Points of Interest Committee is charged with developing a handout which will include a brief history of Marie Dorian and perhaps some pictures; Ms. Clement and Mr. Stai are working on that. Terri Hoag reported that the museum may have a small table at the event but Keizer Heritage does not wish to participate. She added that the Mayor plans to be there or to send someone in her place if she is unable to attend. Ms. Clement concluded noting that author Jane Kirkpatrick is planning on attending and has agreed to be a speaker.

Points of Interest Map – Sherri Gottfried reported that a map had been developed but she did not have it to show to members. She agreed to bring it to the next meeting.
