APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Kim Beesley moved for approval of the February 18, 2010 Volunteer Coordinating Committee minutes. Bee Anderson seconded the Motion.

The Motion passed 4-0-2-1 with David Fifer and Pat Curran absent and Marlene Quinn abstaining due to her absence on February 18, 2010.

KEIZER BIKEWAYS COMMITTEE APPOINTMENT

OTHER BUSINESS

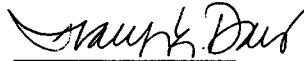
There was no other business to come before the Committee.
