APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Jesse Cuomo moved for approval of the April 2017 minutes. Clay Rushton seconded. Motion passed as follows: Head, Cuomo, Hickman, Gerstner and Rushton in favor with Crenshaw absent and Jackson absent at time of vote.

COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS

Points of Interest: A media release was distributed and an application was received from Crizalise Tamayo. The committee reviewed her application and heard her testimony.

Phil Gerstner moved to close nominations. Jesse Cuomo seconded. Motion passed as follows: Head, Cuomo, Hickman, Gerstner and Rushton in favor with Crenshaw absent and Jackson absent at time of vote.

Jesse Cuomo moved to recommend Council appoint Crizalise Tamayo to serve on the Keizer Points of Interest Committee, Position #2. Phil Gerstner seconded. Motion passed as follows: Head, Cuomo, Hickman, Gerstner, Jackson and Rushton in favor with Crenshaw absent.

Public Arts Commission: A media release was distributed and applications were received from Suesann Abdelrasul and Beth Melendy. The committee reviewed the applications from both candidates and heard their testimony.

Jesse Cuomo moved to close nominations and recommend Council appoint Beth Melendy to serve on the Public Arts Commission, Position #5. Clay Rushton seconded. Motion passed as follows: Head, Cuomo, Hickman, Gerstner, Jackson and Rushton in favor with Crenshaw absent.

Sarah Head moved to recommend Council appoint Suesann Abdelrasul to serve on the Public Arts Commission, Position #2. Larry Jackson seconded. Motion passed as follows: Head, Cuomo, Hickman, Gerstner, Jackson and Rushton in favor with Crenshaw absent.

AMEND PROCESS FOR APPOINTMENTS: Committee members reviewed #7 on the appointment process which related to the Youth Councilor exit survey.

Jesse Cuomo moved to approve #7 in the 'Process for Appointments to City Council Committee' as written. Sara Head seconded. Motion passed as follows: Head, Cuomo, Hickman, Gerstner, Jackson and Rushton in favor with Crenshaw absent.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Staff question about recognition of volunteers: Staff explained that Dorothy Diehl (staff) had indicated that she wanted the volunteers who service the police vehicles to be honored and wished to nominate them as Volunteers of the Quarter. She questioned if it would be appropriate for a staff member to do so and if they could be nominated as a group. Following discussion Committee members agreed by consensus that they approved of staff making a nomination and considering a small group for recognition.

Recruitment continues for the Points of Interest Committee (1 vacancy), Mid-Willamette Valley Community Development Partnership (1 vacancy), and Youth Liaisons for city committees.
