The Meeting was called to order by Hersch Sangster. Minutes from last month were approved

The Cookie Monster Ride by the Salem Bicycle Club on 5/7 was discussed. Bob had solicited feedback from the Neighborhood Associations on the ride and the route. Gubser submitted a letter indicating on how well the ride went. Next year plans will be made for the ride to have the same route. Keizer Chamber is also interested in helping sponsor the ride. The Police did mention concern at Cherry & Manbrim, where several bicyclists may have run the stop sign. Plan will be conducted to reduce this hazard next year.

A helmet fair at the Skate Park in early July of August was discussed. Keizer Rotary has given \$300 to help with a helmet promotion project. The City and Fire Dept. have given money for the KBAC to obtain helmets. The Explorers have not yet responded to the letter sent. Hersch will follow up to see if they can help with the event.
