OTHER BUSINESS

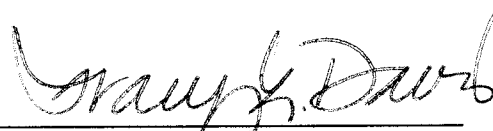
