Becka Brisbin would research some best practices and bring back a draft proposal for the Commission to consider to ensure that Keizer Public Arts Commission was involving as many people as possible to display their artwork at no cost to the City. The Members were encouraged to send their ideas to Ms. Wilson for Ms. Brisbin to include in the proposal.
