Lore,

Attached please find an updated preview and revised quote for the sign done in the oval shape. To get this effect, we propose doing backer plates that would give a lot more dimension and needed contrast to the whole sign. Happy to talk through the explanation if you like. But, here is the basic layout. The first oval has the "KEIZER" script as a positive cutout. We would go to 3/16" thickness for integrity of the cutout and dimension. This piece would be finished in the Blue Hammertone powder coating. Directly behind would be a full oval backer with negative cut outs of "CITY OF" and "SINCE 1982". This piece would be finished in White Texture powder coating. Directly behind the two negative cutouts would be smaller backers finished again in the Blue Hammertone. The whole sign would then be mounted to the wall on standoff mounting for additional dimension and depth. It affected the price by adding the other backer pieces, however, we like the design much, much better. It will always read better with increased legibility and higher contrast. It is a appealing shape and captures more of the spirit of the original logo. Again, happy to discuss details or answer any questions. I am working on getting larger color samples as well.

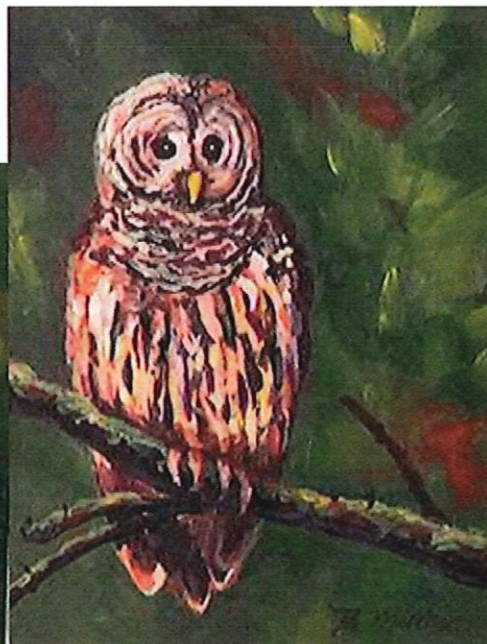
